
I am writing in response to your correspondence to the FBI dated December 11, 2003.

In order for the FBI to initiate an investigation of any allegations we receive, specific facts must be set forth to demonstrate that a violation of federal law within our investigative jurisdiction has occurred. The issues you brought to our attention do not provide sufficient predicate for the FBI to initiate a federal criminal investigation.

If sufficient evidence develops which support your allegations of the violation of public corruption, please forward that information to the Washington Field Office of the FBI for review.
